Marco Roffi is Full Professor of Cardiology, Vice-Chairman of Cardiology, and Director of the Interventional Cardiology Unit at the University Hospitals of Geneva, Switzerland. After the Swiss board certification in internal medicine, he entered fellowship in general and then interventional cardiology with Prof. Bernhard Meier at the University Hospital of Berne, Switzerland. Following Swiss board certification in cardiology, he attended a two-year advanced fellowship in coronary, peripheral and carotid interventions at the Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio, under the leadership of Prof. Eric J. Topol. He was subsequently appointed by Prof. Thomas F. Lüscher as staff member and subsequently co-director of the Andreas Grüntzig Cardiovascular Catheterization Laboratories at the University Hospital of Zurich, Switzerland. Since 2008, he leads the interventional cardiology unit at the University Hospitals of Geneva, Switzerland. In 2013, he was appointed Vice-Chairman of Cardiology. His clinical and research fields of interest include acute coronary syndromes, antiplatelet therapy, coronary artery disease in diabetes, and carotid as well as peripheral interventions.
